

\$15,000 FELLOWSHIPS & SCHOLARSHIPS

- The Department of Philosophy at Georgia State University is offering two Brains & Behavior Fellowships, a Legal/Political Philosophy Scholarship, and a German Philosophy Scholarship to well-qualified students applying to its highly-regarded Master's program.
- The Department has particular areas of faculty strength in Legal/Political Philosophy, Neurophilosophy, and German Philosophy. In addition, with the University Brains & Behavior Program, students working in neurophilosophy have an opportunity to work with distinguished faculty in other departments at Georgia State.
- Fellowships and Scholarships cover tuition, provide \$15,000/year for living expenses and up to \$500/year for travel to conferences. Fellowships have no teaching duties for two years. Scholarships have no duties in the first year but do require teaching in the second year.
