

# Sandrock Intermediate Climbing Trip

Belay certification at our indoor climbing wall is a requirement for this trip. Sport Lead Climbing Clinic on October 8<sup>th</sup> highly recommended for the avid climber if you don't have previous sport climbing experience. This trip is designed as an intermediate trip for those wanting to test their skills that they have acquired on our indoor climbing wall and previous beginner rock climbing trips. We will be working through a variety of routes to give everyone a challenging and rewarding experience. There will be plenty of bouldering opportunities to work on as well in the down time between climbs.

We will depart from behind the Sports Arena on Collins Street at 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Park in G deck and be aware there is a \$6 parking fee without a valid GSU parking permit.

## **RECOMMENDATION: CUT YOUR FINGERNAILS!!!!**

You should bring your own lunch and plenty of water to keep hydrated. We will stop for fast food on the way up and for dinner on the way back, so bring money for that or pack your own food from home. Wear comfortable walking shoes and bring rain gear just in case. Wear appropriate clothing to adjust to changing temperatures throughout the day. If you have your own climbing gear bring it, otherwise we will provide it.

You will receive a call prior to the trip to confirm trip logistics. You will also receive a call if the trip is canceled for any reason
