Program Description

Executives with undergraduate degrees in areas other than business and commerce are required to take following prerequisite courses.

- Essentials of Business Administration
- Essentials of Accounting
- Essentials of Economics

Core Courses:

First Semester

- Managerial Economics
- Organizational Behavior
- Financial Accounting & Reporting
- Decision Support Tools

Second Semester

- Leadership
- Financial & Investment Decision-making
- Business Regulations & Fiscal Policies
- Managerial Accounting & Control

Third Semester

- Strategic Marketing
- International Business Management
- Information Technology Strategy
- Elective Course

Fourth Semester

- Business Strategy
- Research Project
- Elective Course

During the third and fourth semester, each student undertakes an elective course of their choice. The electives can be chosen from a wide range of offerings in the fields of Finance, Marketing, Accounting, Human Resources and Business Strategy.

Graduates will earn both an Executive MBA (EMBA) degree from Alexandria University – Faculty of Commerce and an EMBA certificate from Georgia State University – Robinson College of Business.

Location and Format

The EMBA program has a convenient Alexandria locale and a branch in Cairo with international residency in Atlanta, USA. The 24-month program begins in September and classes are held with a flexible schedule either weekly on Fridays and Saturdays or monthly for five consecutive days.

To help balance work, school and personal commitments, students just take two courses at a time.

Fees

Program fees are \$8,000 USD for the total program excluding residency in the USA.
