

**Student Activity Fee Committee**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**Lanier Suite**  
**March 19, 2010**

The Student Activity Fee Committee met on March 19, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. in Lanier Suite and took the following actions:

I. Approval of Minutes

Greg Abt moved to approve the minutes of the February 26, 2010 meeting. This motion was seconded by Robert Holbrook and unanimously approved.

II. Student Activity Fee Committee Spring Meeting Schedule

III. University-Wide Deliberation/Vote

Terrance Rogers moved to decrease the Rialto Student Ambassadors by \$3,670 to \$2,050. This motion was seconded by Eric Blacknall and approved by the following vote:

Terrance Rogers moved to increase Delta Phi Lambda Sorority Inc. by \$7,050 to \$9,400. This motion was seconded by Matthew Robison.

Joann Bacon moved to amend the motion to increase Delta Phi Lambda Sorority Inc. by \$2,650 to \$5,000. T. Rogers and M. Robison accepted this as a friendly amendment. It was approved by the following vote: Yes: 8 No: 0 Abstain: 0

Eric Blacknall moved to increase the Nontraditional Students Assoc by \$1,000 to \$3,570. This motion was seconded by Terrance Rogers and approved by the following vote:

Matthew Robison moved to increase Progressive Student Alliance by \$1,000 to \$2,170. This motion was seconded by Eric Blacknall and approved by the following vote:

Terrance Rogers moved to increase Panther Breakaway by \$1,420 to \$7,950. This motion was seconded by Joann Bacon and approved by the following vote:

Eric Blacknall moved to increase Nu Delta Chapter of Delta Epsilon Iota by \$410 to \$2,450. This motion was seconded by Mary Yupari and approved by the following vote:

Matthew Robison moved to increase Sustainable Energy Tribe by \$168 to \$2,000. This motion was seconded by Terrance Rogers and approved by the following vote:

Yes: 5 No: 0 Abstain: 3

Christopher Sumter moved to increase Social Justice Project by \$390 to \$2,000. This motion was seconded by Eric Blacknall and approved by the following vote:

Yes: 8 No: 0 Abstain: 0

Eric Blacknall moved to distribute the remaining funding (\$1,891) proportionately among the groups who had not received additional funding in any of the previous amendments. The additional allocations are as follows: Amnesty International @GSU - \$178, Student Veterans Association - \$946, Taking A Stand In Communities - \$196, Theta Nu Xi Multicultural Sorority, Inc. - \$241, and University Speakers Association - \$330. This motion was seconded by Christopher Sumter and approved by the following vote:

The committee unanimously approved the University-Wide budget as amended.
