

The Henry Ford Museum - Historical Resources Internship Program (Dearborn, Michigan, U.S.)

Designed for students enrolled in undergraduate or graduate programs in history, American studies, museum studies or related fields, the Historical Resources Internship Program provides participants with an opportunity to volunteer in a major American history museum.

Each volunteer intern will work directly with a curator, registrar, archivist, librarian or conservator who serves as a mentor. In addition to completing specific project assignments, Historical Resources interns are encouraged to participate in the larger life of the institution in order to gain a more comprehensive understanding of the varied aspects of museum work.

Terms of Internship

Historical Resources Internships are volunteer positions, usually 3 to 5 days per week over three months during the summer.

Intern positions for summer 2009 projects have been filled. Projects for summer 2010 will be listed on the website in December 2009, with application deadline of Monday, March 15, 2010.
