General Description

Fabricates and repairs furniture and cabinets.

Examples of Duties

- Builds and repairs all types of furniture including, cabinets, tables, shelves, desks, bookcases, bulletin boards, chairs and other wooden equipment.
- Lays out material, machinery, and assembly.
- Repairs and cleans furniture for refurbishing including the fabrication of new parts and finish removal.
- Builds and repairs windows.
- Operates various types of machinery such as mortisers, shapers, rip saw, joiner, planer, bandsaws and related equipment.
- May fabricate special wooden parts and components.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of equipment and tools used in fabricating and repairing furniture and cabinets.
- Ability to read and interpret prints, drawings, and schematics.
- Knowledge of computer applications relating to area of assignment.
- Skill and ability to use tools properly in the repair and fabrication of furniture.
- Knowledge of safety practices and procedures within area of assignment.

Minimum GSU Hiring Standards

High school diploma or GED and five years experience; or a technical or a vocational degree and three years experience; or a combination of education and experience.
