General Description

Performs skilled manual work involving the building, repairing, refinishing and installation of office furniture; woodwork, etc.

Examples of Duties

- Builds and repairs desks, tables, chairs, bookcases, etc.
- Builds room partitions and other structures.
- Studies blueprints and building plans to determine materials needed and dimensions of structures.
- Selects building materials.
- Repairs and maintains doors, cabinets, bookcases, floors and other structures.
- Installs doors, windows, tiles, floors, ceilings, etc.
- Performs bench work in the carpentry shop.
- Marks cutting and assembly lines on materials; shapes material to prescribed measurements.
- Assembles, cuts and shapes materials and fastens them together.
- Erects framework for structures and lays sub-flooring.
- Applies decorative material to walls and ceilings.
- Fits and installs prefabricated windows, doors, etc.
- Constructs forms and chutes for pouring concrete.
- Erects scaffolds and ladders to assist with performing duties.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of equipment, practices and procedures of the carpentry trade.
- Ability to use hand tools and power tools of the carpentry trade.
- Ability to climb ladders and scaffolds.
- Ability to access confined spaces.
- Ability to interpret blueprints.
- Ability to follow written and oral instruction.

Minimum GSU Hiring Standards

Technical or vocational degree and one year experience; or a high school diploma or GED and three years experience; or a combination of education and experience.
