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### **General Description**

Provides professional level technical support for client/server databases. Technical support will include the installation, maintenance, analysis, tuning, and troubleshooting of databases systems.

### **Examples of Duties**

- Analyzes, tunes, and troubleshoots database system performance.
- Designs, develops, and maintains specialized software applications.
- Provides end-user or client support for database systems.
- Updates or creates changes to existing database architecture upon request.
- Provides consulting and training to lower level technical and programming staff.
- Performs other Client/Server Database duties as assigned.

### **Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities**

- Knowledge of data processing principles, practices, and equipment.
- Knowledge of integrated systems and relational database concepts and systems.
- Ability to multi-task, train staff, and use independent judgment.
