General Description

Performs skilled manual work that requires a working knowledge of painting practices and methods.

Examples of Duties

- Cleans and prepares surfaces to be painted by use of sandpaper, steel wool, scrapers or soap and water.
- Fills nail holes, cracks and joints with caulk, putty, plaster or other filler to prepare surface for painting.
- Removes lights and other fixtures to prepare surface for painting.
- Spreads drop cloths over floors and furniture.
- Paints interior and exterior walls and ceilings with brushes, rollers and spray guns.
- Varnishes, stains and finishes desks, cabinets and other furniture.
- Trims windows and doors.
- Caulks and glazes windows.
- Mixes paints, varnishes, shellacs and enamels.
- Cleans and stores brushes.
- Erects and moves scaffolds.
- Cleans work areas after project is completed.
- Serves as a lead worker on painting assignments.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of painting methods and procedures.
- Ability to communicate orally and in writing.
- Ability to properly mix paints, etc.
- Ability to climb ladders, scaffolds, etc.
- Ability to access confined spaces.
- Ability to lift paint cans and other painting supplies.

High school diploma or GED and three years experience.
