General Description

Maintains, lay out, assembles and installs pipe systems, pipe supports and related equipment for hot/cold water supplies, drains, plumbing fixtures and automatic fire sprinkling systems.

Examples of Duties

- Modifies the fire sprinkler systems including the installation and/or relocation of sprinkler heads.
- Installs, and repair plumbing fixtures, such as sinks, commodes, bathtubs, water heaters, hot water tanks, garbage disposal units, dishwashers, and water softeners.
- Threads pipe using pie-threading machine.
- Assembles and installs variety of metal and nonmetal pipes, tubes, and fittings, including iron, steel, cooper, and plastic.
- Connects pipes, using threaded, caulked, soldered, brazed, fused, or cemented joints, and hand tools.
- Repairs and maintains plumbing by replacing washers in leaky faucets, mending burst pipes, and clogged drains.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of standard plumbing and fire sprinkler systems and their respective codes.
- Must be able to work in confined spaces.
- Ability to lift and carry up to 50 lbs.
- Ability to read blueprints, drawings, and schematics.
- Ability to multi-task in a deadline driven environment.
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.

Minimum GSU Hiring Standards

Technical or vocational degree and six years experience; or high school diploma or GED and eight years experience; or a combination of education and experience.
