Frequently Asked Questions

- ❖ Will members have to adjust deductions themselves? **No, the credit union will move all affected employees to the proper payroll frequency.**
- ❖ Will non-credit union members have to deal with their financial institution or is there help available through the credit union? **Unfortunately the credit union is unable to provide assistance to non-members. It is suggested that non-members contact their financial institutions and creditors. They should inform them of the payroll change and inquire as to their recommendations.**
- ❖ Do employees have to be members of the credit union in order to participate in financial options? **Yes, Federal Law requires that one be a member of a credit union in order to receive financial assistance in the form of loans or credit cards.**
- ❖ Will employees have availability to emergency loans? **Employees who are members of the credit union will have access to emergency loans. Special rates and terms will be provided.**
- ❖ What other non-financial options are available? **Employees with outstanding credit union loans have the option to skip a payment, all fees will be waived.**
