Requirements: Requires Masters/equivalent in Economics or Public Administration with 2 years experience in Public Finance and Fiscal Policy to include writing reports, doing research, providing training, and conducting technical assistance in developing and/or transitional countries in one of the following areas: fiscal decentralization, intergovernmental fiscal relations, tax policy, or public budgeting. Experience may be gained concurrently. International travel up to 40 percent.

Job description: Responsible for conducting advanced research of a technical nature regarding intergovernmental fiscal relations, tax policy, and budgeting, leading to the publication of referred papers and generation of grant funds. Will conduct advanced research, maintain externally funded grant funds and contracts or their equivalent, and develop and manage research project budgets. Will provide training to government practitioners regarding fiscal decentralization and intergovernmental transfers, including Fiscal Policy Training Courses and country-specific training courses. Will perform advanced planning and develop future research projects. Will develop and write proposals for research grants. May supervise technical staff (Post Doctoral Assistants, Research Technicians, etc.) and or administrative staff (graduate research assistants, student assistants, clerical staff). Will develop manuscripts and presentations, coordinate research projects in the absence of principal researcher, and perform other advanced research duties as assigned by the Center Director.
