## **Georgia State University seeks nominations for the Hosea Williams Award for Community Activism**

ATLANTA – Georgia State’s Office of the Dean of Students/Intercultural Relations is seeking nominations for the Hosea Williams Award for Community Activism.

The award honors an individual and organization that demonstrate purposeful risk taking for betterment of a community, strong leadership skills and courage. It will be presented as part of the 6th annual King Commemorative Week Celebration in January 2010.

The deadline for nominations is Oct.19. The nomination applications are available through Student Activities in Suite 330 of the Georgia State Student Center, and at online [www2.gsu.edu/interculturalrelations](http://www2.gsu.edu/interculturalrelations).

Nominees must submit two letters of recommendation, a color photo (jpeg/high resolution only) and a 150 word biographical sketch. Resumes must be submitted for individual nominees with contact information included.

Organizations must have 501(c) 3 status to be eligible and submit a fact sheet of the organization’s accomplishments and activities. Supplemental materials such as certificates, news articles and other related documentation about the nominee’s accomplishments are highly recommended.

Last year, Mike “Stinger” Glenn, is currently an analyst for the Atlanta Hawks. Inspired by his hearing-impaired school friends who could not attend summer basketball camps, Mr. Glenn, along with friend Reggie Johnson, formed a basketball camp for hearing impaired athletes, won the individual award. The organizational award recipient was After – School All- Stars Atlanta, an organization that provides after school programming to over 1, 500 inner city middle school children.
