Georgia State University seeks alumni nominations for Torch of Peace Award

ATLANTA – Georgia State’s Office of the Dean of Students/Intercultural Relations and the Alumni Association are seeking alumni nominations for the 2010 Martin Luther King, Jr. Torch of Peace Award. The award will be presented as part of the 6th annual King Commemorative Week Celebration in January 2010.

For the eighth year, a Torch of Peace Alumni Award will be presented to individuals who have demonstrated an outstanding ability to facilitate or promote positive intercultural relations at Georgia State or in the community at large.

The deadline for all nominations is Oct. 12. A complete packet includes the nominator form, the nominee’s resume, two letters of recommendation, one color photograph (jpeg high resolution only) and a 150 word biographical sketch. Supplemental materials such as certificates, newspaper articles and other related materials documenting the nominee’s accomplishments are highly recommended.
