



## Georgia State University Department of Applied Linguistics/ESL

The Intensive English Program at Georgia State University is now accepting applications for the following positions:

- Two (2) full-time, 9-month, non-tenure track Lecturer positions

Ideal candidates will have native-like proficiency in English, MA in TESOL or closely related field, and at least 3 years of full-time ESL teaching experience working with students from a broad range of L1 backgrounds in a university setting. Experience in teaching English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is preferred. Responsibilities include:

- Teach 12 contact hours a week/semester during academic year (willingness to teach during the summer for additional compensation encouraged)
- Demonstrate excellence in planning, presentation, and classroom management skills
- Develop appropriate supplemental materials for assigned classes
- Demonstrate ability to adapt to new techniques/situations related to teaching assignment
- Attend and provide input at departmental and programmatic meetings
- Assess students' performance in an accurate and unbiased manner
- Keep students informed of their progress through regular formal and informal feedback
- Treat all students fairly and impartially, maintaining cultural sensitivity
- Assist with registration, testing, and placement testing each semester and as needed
- Meet responsibilities and deadlines for recording attendance, grades, etc.
- Maintain regular office hours for consultation with students and colleagues
- Display courtesy and effectively interact within the department and University community
- Cooperate with colleagues by sharing ideas and materials willingly and by being accessible and dependable
- Volunteer to work on projects with Applied Linguistics faculty and graduate students (e.g. act as cooperating teacher for practicum students)
- Consistently strive to grow professionally and to contribute to the profession
- Support and occasionally participate in social, recreational and cultural activities scheduled for students

The Lecturer positions are continuing faculty appointments and have departmental and college service expectations. These positions are renewable annually based on successful review processes (annual, three-year, and five year). The starting salary is \$37,000 with full benefits.
