

TEST PREPARATION COURSES

Website: www.mathstat.gsu.edu/mathprep.htm Texts are available for purchase at the first class for LSAT and GMATmath. Deadline for pre-registration is 3 p.m. the business day before the start of the course.

All courses will have a \$10 discount if the application and fees are received in the Department of Mathematics and Statistics exactly one week before the course starts. Walk-ins are accepted, but there will be an extra charge of \$10 for any registration received after 4 pm the day before the course is to begin.

GMAT Math Preparation

Review mathematical concepts, algebra, geometry, and charts and graphs concepts. Learn shortcuts and strategies for solving test questions and practice with past tests. Text: Myers' Methods for Mastering the GMAT" is required, and "The Official Guide for GMAT Review" will be used as an optional book.

GMAT VERBAL PREPARATION

The verbal prep course will review the concepts necessary to successfully complete the VERBAL portion of the GMAT. The instructor will be Margaret Lee, an experienced teacher of test preparation. \$189 plus books

GRE Math Preparation

Gain confidence in your math abilities with this excellent review of arithmetic, algebra, geometry, and word problems of all sorts. Work with sample examination problems to learn strategies and shortcuts for understanding and solving them. Required texts: "Practicing to Take the GRE General Test," latest edition. Learn the verbal skills necessary to taking the GRE. The text will be "Practicing to Take the GRE".

LSAT PREPARATION (MATH + VERBAL)

This course will review the necessary materials for successful completion of the LSAT. The instructors for the course are Dr. Philip Tiu, who has been doing test prep for many years. Cost of the course: \$229 plus books.

REGISTRATION POLICIES Cancellations must be received 2 business days before a class begins to receive a refund, minus a \$10 administrative charge. Refunds will not be issued after the first class meeting. Stop payment of a check does not constitute a formal cancellation. We will charge you a \$15 fee or 5 percent of the face amount of the check; whichever is greater, for stop payments or returned checks. Allow two to three weeks from the date of cancellation to receive a refund. We permit participant substitutions at any time, and one transfer with less than 50% of course attendance. Late registration will incur a \$10 late administrative fee. We do take walk-ins, but will impose the late registration fee. We encourage everyone to register early, so that books and materials will be ready for you on the first day of class.
