What is Metro Atlanta Academic WorldQuest?

Metro Atlanta Academic WorldQuest is a high school team competition that tests contestants' knowledge of international topics including Current Events, World Music, International Migration, Pandemics and more.

Winners from this competition will represent Metro Atlanta and compete with teams from across the country at the national competition in Washington D.C. on the weekend of April 23-25, 2010.

Who Can Participate?

Teams of interested high school students.

A team consists of four high school students from grades 9-12. Teams may be accompanied by a faculty coach. (One alternate team member is welcome at the Atlanta competition.) As soon as your school's registration form and fee are received we'll rush you the "Great Decisions 2009 Study Guide" and links to support team preparations.

What is the competition like?

The competition will involve ten rounds of ten multiple choice questions each. Answer sheets are submitted following each round and the team with the highest overall points wins the "Metro Atlanta Academic WorldQuest Championship" and represents Metro Atlanta at the national competition. The four winning team members plus one coach will be flown to the national competition in Washington to represent Metro Atlanta.

Prizes:

Medals will be awarded to the top three teams. Students going to the national competition will be sponsored and Certificates of Participation will be awarded to all participating schools. Travel and accommodations will be provided for the team of four plus one coach going to the national competition. Certificates of Participation will be awarded to all schools.
