

Co-Sponsorship FAQs

Who can apply for co-sponsorship?

All chartered student organizations and university departments. Charter status will be verified by the Office of Student Life and Leadership.

Is there a cap for the amount requested?

*Each request is reviewed and the amounts are allocated on a case by case basis. Past **maximum** allocations have been approximately \$1,000 per event. Organizations may submit multiple requests throughout the year but not for the same event.*

Are late applications accepted?

Late applications will not be accepted.

When will the organization receive confirmation that the application was received?

You will be notified by SGA Vice President of Student Life that your application was received within 2 business days.

When will the organization know whether the request was approved or denied?

You will be notified via email and phone confirmation from the SGA Vice President of Student Life within 2 weeks acknowledging approval or denial of request.

If a co-sponsorship request is denied, is there an appeals process?

Yes. If you would like to know why the request was denied and potential ways to strengthen the application, contact the SGA Vice President of Student Life. Participation in the appeals process does not guarantee funding; it only indicates that the request may be reconsidered.

What kind of events does SGA sponsor?

SGA has sponsored numerous student organization and departmental events. While there is no specific type of event that can receive funding, the goal is to assist with events that have broad appeal to the student body at Georgia State. Examples of previously-sponsored events include:

- *T.A.P.E. Intercultural Fair – Student Life and Leadership/Intercultural Relations*
- *Holiday Networking Party – Public Relations Student Society of America at Georgia State*
- *Fast-a-Thon – Muslim Student Association*
- *Finals Breakfast – Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Incorporated/Kappa Theta Chapter*
- *Relay for Life – Colleges Against Cancer*

How do we receive the money?

The SGA Advisor will process all financial transactions related to the expenditure of co-sponsorship funds. Student organizations must contact the SGA Administrative Assistant within 3 business days of notification of approval to schedule a meeting with the SGA Advisor to discuss the purchases needed for the event.



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
