1. Formulating an ad hoc committee would solely be responsible for the orchestration of the Senate Awards Gala which would take place on March 21st, 2008; which would be chaired by the President pro tempore.
2. Have the Vice-President for Budget and Finance allocate the amount of \$2,000 from the 2007-2008 Student Government Association Senate budget, that will be used to carry out the goals of this legislation.

3. Have the Vice-Presidents of the current standing committees serve as committee advisors for the individual recognition of various senators within their respective standing committees.
