Whereas the Regents are discussing a new curriculum but providing very few details; and

Whereas Category Areas A-E may be changed and instead of being a traditional 60 hours, the Regents are proposing a core curriculum that can be completed in one year, limiting the hours to 30 but possibly causing undue stress on students by requiring several analytical and intensive writing courses be taken at the same time; and

Whereas the Student Government Association is mandated by their constitution to serve as partners in the administrative processes of the University; and

Therefore let it be resolved that the Student Government Association is in favor of the following:

The Vice President for Academic Affairs writing a letter to the Administration and Regents asking for more details so that discussion may occur on these proposed changes.
