Whereas the purpose of the Student Government Association is to provide a responsive forum for student opinions and interests and to actively seek out, investigate and resolve student complaints and concerns; and

Whereas the Student Government Association is the official voice of the students; and

Whereas in recent years, the University has made an effort to streamline and clarify its policies, procedures, and image; and

Whereas in 2006, the University’s Division of Student Services changed its name to the Division of Student Affairs; and

Whereas the Vice President of Student Services of the Student Government Association is still known and titled as such, even though the University has made the switch; and

Whereas this has led to confusion by students, faculty, and staff when defining the role and purpose of this position, leading to a lack of continuity between the University and SGA; and

Whereas the Student Government Association is mandated by their constitution to serve as partners in the administrative processes of the University; and

Therefore let it be resolved that the Student Government Association is favor of the following:

Effective May 1, 2009, after the election of the 2009-10 Student Government Association, the Vice President for Student Services shall henceforth be known as the “Vice President for Student Affairs,” and the Student Services Committee shall be known as the “Student Affairs Committee.” All references in the Constitution and Bylaws shall be amended to reflect this.
