Whereas the purpose of the Student Government Association is to provide a responsive forum for student opinions and interests and to actively seek out, investigate and resolve student complaints and concerns; and

Whereas the Student Government Association is the official voice of the students; and

Whereas the security and safety of the students while on campus is the responsibility of the University; and

Whereas recent events have shown that campus security and safety is an important concern; and

Whereas the Student Government Association is mandated by their constitution to serve as partners in the administrative processes of the University; and

Therefore let it be resolved that the Student Government Association is in favor of the following:

To create a committee to investigate any possible deficiencies in Georgia State University’s security services and to ascertain any possible solutions, and to lobby the University Senate to direct university faculty to instruct their students in the university’s currently available security services and other alternative safety and security practices that students could perform. In addition, the Student Government Association will also work in tandem with other University committees already working on this issue.
